

Resolution no. 691
of the Senate of the SGH Warsaw School of Economics
of 31 March 2020

on the reassumption of resolution no. 686 of the Senate of the SGH Warsaw School of Economics of 26 February 2020 on the rules of collecting fees, including fees for educational services provided at the first and second cycle degree studies, and terms and conditions, as well as the mode of fee exemption

Pursuant to Article 79 par. 3 of the Act of 20 July 2018 on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws of 2020, item 85), in conjunction with par. 47 subpar. 1 point 19 of the Statutes of the SGH Warsaw School of Economics constituting annex to resolution no. 499 of the Senate of the SGH Warsaw School of Economics of 29 May 2019 on the Statutes of the SGH Warsaw School of Economics, as amended, and par. 15 subpar. 3 of the Rules and Regulations of Sessions of the Senate of the SGH Warsaw School of Economics, constituting annex to resolution no. 100 of the Senate of the SGH Warsaw School of Economics of 15 March 2017 on the Rules and Regulations of Sessions of the SGH Warsaw School of Economics, as amended, it is hereby resolved as follows:

§ 1

“The rules of collecting fees, including fees for educational services provided at the first and second cycle degree studies, and terms and conditions, as well as the mode of fee exemption” constituting annex to the resolution are hereby stipulated.

§ 2

Resolution no. 686 of the Senate of the SGH Warsaw School of Economics of 26 February 2020 on the rules of collecting fees, including fees for educational services provided at the first and second cycle degree studies, and terms and conditions, as well as the mode of fee exemption, is hereby repealed.

§ 3

The Resolution enters into force on the day of its passing.
