Resolution no. 74
of the Senate of SGH Warsaw School of Economics
of 24 February 2021

amending Resolution no. 741 of the Senate of SGH Warsaw School of Economics of 24 June 2020 on the terms and conditions and the mode of recruitment for the 1st year of full-time and part-time first and second cycle degree studies at SGH Warsaw School of Economics in the academic year 2021/2022

Pursuant to Article 70 par. 1 of the Act of 20 July 2018 – the Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws of 2020, items 85, 374, 695, 875 and 1086, of 2021 item 159) in conjunction with Article 79 par. 5aa of the Act of 16 April 2020 on special support instruments with regard to the spread of SARS-CoV-2 (Journal of Laws, item 695, as amended) and par. 47 subpar. 1 point 15 of the Statute of SGH Warsaw School of Economics constituting annex to Resolution no. 499 of the Senate of SGH Warsaw School of Economics of 29 May 2019, as amended, it is hereby resolved as follows:

§ 1

The following amendments are introduced to Resolution no. 741 of the Senate of SGH Warsaw School of Economics of 24 June 2020 on the terms and conditions and the mode of recruitment for the 1st year of full-time and part-time first and second cycle degree studies at SGH Warsaw School of Economics in the academic year 2021/2022:

1) in par. 3, subpar. 3 is added in the following wording:

“3. The principles of starting studies by participants of the double diploma programme referred to studies by a partner university are specified under provisions of the agreement concluded by SGH Warsaw School of Economics and a given partner university.”;

2) in par. 14:

a) in subpar. 1 points 1 and 2 receive the following wording:

- “1) first cycle degree studies – start on 10 June 2021 (a possibility of setting up an account as of 10 May 2021, at 12:00 p.m.), and end 5 days after announcement of the baccalaureate exam results by the relevant authority and if this day falls on a public holiday, the term of closing the registration falls on the first consecutive business day;
- 2) second cycle degree studies – start on 8 June 2021 (a possibility of setting up an account as of 10 May 2021, at 12:00 p.m.), and end on 23 June 2021.”,
- b) subpar. 5 receives the following wording:
- “5. The possibility of registering in the IRS form closes at 4:00 p.m. of the standard time in the territory of the Republic of Poland, on the last day of the period of relevant recruitment.”;
- 3) in par. 16:
- a) subpar. 5 receives the following wording:
- “5. Until closing registration in the IRS recruitment form, the candidate has the right to supplement and change data entered into the IRS. Changing the candidate’s personal data (citizenship, PESEL (Personal Identification Number), date of birth and sex) is possible provided that the candidate has not selected the level of studies. Otherwise, one should deregister from the IRS recruitment form, change the aforementioned data and re-select proper recruitment form of SGH Warsaw School of Economics. Contact data in the IRS can be updated until the end of the recruitment process understood as entry into the list of students or receiving decision on non-admission to studies.”,
- b) subpar. 6 is added in the following wording:
- “6. Candidate qualified to the second cycle degree studies indicates that he or she graduated from a high school level of education in Poland or abroad.”;
- 4) in par. 18 subpar. 2 receives the following wording:
- “2. The recruitment fee is not reimbursable, unless it has been paid past the deadline or the candidate has resigned, in a written form or via the IRS, from participation in the recruitment before closing the IRS recruitment form or the candidate’s registration was ineffective and he or she did not participate in the qualification proceedings. The fee is reimbursed upon the candidate’s motion to the bank account indicated in the motion.”;
- 5) in par. 21 subpar. 1 and 2 receive the following wording:

- “1. The grounds for admission at the full-time first cycle degree studies in Polish constitute the baccaureate exam results and the entrepreneurship knowledge test results.
 2. The grounds for admission at the part-time first cycle degree studies in Polish constitute the baccaureate exam results.”;
- 6) in par. 26 subpar. 1 introduction to the enumeration receives the following wording:
- “1. Candidates, who passed the New Baccaureate, receive qualification points on the grounds of the results of the baccaureate exam’s written part from:”;
- 7) in par. 32 subpar. 1 introduction to the enumeration receives the following wording:
- “1. For the enumerated below sports achievements in the discipline subject to the Polish Sports Association (in accordance with the list of the Minister of Sport and Tourism) the candidate receives an additional number of points in the qualification proceedings, whereas, the total number of points cannot exceed 433. In the case the candidate meets the criteria of more than one of the following, only the achievement with the highest number of points is taken into consideration:”;
- 8) in par. 15 subpar. 3, par. 19 subpar. 1, par. 41 subpar. 1, 3 and 4, par. 50 and par. 53 the name “Promotion and Admissions Department” is replaced with the name “Admissions Department”, as appropriate;
- 9) in par. 43, subpar. 3 in point 3 dot is replaced with a semicolon and point 4 is added in the following wording:
- “4) candidates who participated in the recruitment on the grounds of the diploma of graduating first cycle degree studies at SGH Warsaw School of Economics after 1 October 2019 are released from the obligation to submit the diploma.”;
- 10) in the annex to the Resolution:
- a) point 2 receives the following wording:
 - “2. Polish baccaureate certificate including information on the obtained result from the baccaureate exam in English at an advanced or bilingual level (required at least 70 percentage points).”;
 - b) in point 5 letter d receives the following wording:
 - “d) **Edexcel, Pearson Language Tests**, Pearson Language Assessments – especially the following certificates: **London Tests of English**, Level 3 (Edexcel Level 1 Certificate in ESOL International); **London Tests of English**, Level 4 (Edexcel Level 2 Certificate in ESOL International);

London Tests of English, Level 5 (Edexcel Level 3 Certificate in ESOL International), PTE Academic (at least B2)".

§ 2
